- The education exhibit area is located on east River Street adjacent to the Waving Girl statue.
- Please bring your own snacks and drinks; unfortunately there are no funds to provide these amenities to our exhibitors and volunteers. Casual restaurants are within short walking distances.
- The nearest, nicest public restrooms are at the Visitor's Center on River Street just east of the Hyatt and at the Marriott on the far east end of the Riverfront; both are an easy five-minute walk from *Kid's Cove - NOAA Planet Ocean in Motion*.
- Free electricity and WiFi are available in the education exhibit area. Water access is limited.
- Free parking for exhibitors and volunteers will be issued for the Marriott parking lot.
