

Gray's Reef National Marine Sanctuary is Georgia's amazing underwater park. Located just 16 miles off the coast of Georgia, Gray's Reef is best known for its teeming marine life, from colorful corals and sponges to sea turtles, whales and important fish species. This 22-square-mile sanctuary is a treasure for skilled scuba divers and fishermen. Within sanctuary waters, a living mosaic of sea stars, soft corals and sponges cover rocky outcroppings, creating a home for hundreds more species of crabs, shrimp, fish and other organisms.

National marine sanctuaries seek to preserve the extraordinary scenic beauty, biodiversity and economic productivity of America's system of underwater parks. For more than 40 years, our national marine sanctuaries have worked to protect special places in America's marine and Great Lakes waters. One of these unique places is right here in Georgia. By acting as responsible stewards of these special places, we strengthen our nation now and for future generations.

Humpback Whales 3D

Journey to the South Pacific
